This program is back in person, after an unfortunate Covid hiatus, and working to provide this high-demand offering in a safe and efficient way. Showcase Luncheon: The luncheon event features students speaking and presenting displays of career exploration experiences to regional leadership in schools, businesses, and community. 8-county regional Superintendents, CTC Technical Directors, CEOs, State-agencies who are typically in robust attendance.
